ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

The overall goal of this scholarship is to help students financially so they can devote more time to their studies and succeed in completing their nuclear engineering degree. The amount of award will range from \$1,000-\$2,000. The scholarship is named for Dr. Glenn Whan, who during his tenure at UNM served as the chair of the Department of Nuclear Engineering and later as the dean of the School of Engineering.

ELIGIBILITY

- First priority will be given to incoming sophomores with a 3.0 GPA, U.S. citizens (priority for New Mexico residents) in nuclear engineering.
- Students must have a financial need for scholarships.
- ²⁰ Students must maintain a 3.2 GPA in subsequent semesters after freshman year.
- Students must be enrolled in 15 credit hours per semester and with at least 12 credit hours per semester in technical courses toward the nuclear engineering degree.
